



Numeracy Workshop, Day 2

4:00-4:15: Icebreaker Activity: **Two truths and a lie** - Leaders will go in the front of the class and say two truths about themselves and one lie. Then, students will write which statement they think is a lie on a small whiteboard or piece of paper and hold it into the air. (Students who wrote down the lie will receive one token which they can later trade in for candy).

4:15-5:00: Math Olympics- students will be divided into teams of 4. In each group, students will be provided with a whiteboard, an eraser, and a dry erase marker. The leaders will then put challenging math and critical thinking problems up in front of the class and students will have 3-5 minutes to complete the problems. During this time, students should work together and talk frequently while trying to solve the problems. At the end of the 3-5 minutes, students will show the leaders a final answer, *and if correct, each student will receive 1 token.*

Buddies: Pass out snacks during this time

5:00-5:10: Lastly students will then separate and the leaders will show a final challenge question. Students, on their own, will have 10 minutes to try and solve the challenge question. If students can answer it correctly, *they will receive 2 tokens.*

5:10-5:30: Homework Time. Students can work with buddies on their homework and trade in their tokens for prizes. **12 tokens is a large candy. 8 tokens is a medium candy. 4 tokens is a small candy.**
